














LIBRARY NEWS

The WG Libraries are bustling with activity! Students in Granger are excited to access the library again and have already checked out over 1800 books!

Here are some guidelines to help the libraries continue to run smoothly:

Early Learning Center

- Students may have one book checked out at a time.
- Books are due the day before the next time they have library class, so generally a week later. (i.e. - if library class is on Day 3, books are due on Day 2)
- If they cannot return their book, they will need to wait until it has been returned to check out a new one.
- Each student is given a sturdy book bag to transport their library book to and from school. If the bag is lost or damaged, a plastic grocery bag or ziplock bag can be used instead.
- Parents are responsible for the expense of replacing any books lost or damaged beyond repair.

Elementary

- Students may have two books checked out at a time.
- Books are due the day before the next time they have library class, so generally a week later. (i.e. - if library class is on Day 3, books are due on Day 2)
- If they cannot return their book, they will need to wait until it has been returned to check out a new one.
- Students may renew a book up to two times, unless the book is on hold for another student. However, the book must be presented in person for renewal.
- Parents are responsible for the expense of replacing any books lost or damaged beyond repair.

MS/HS

- Students may have two books checked out at a time, unless they have a special class project that requires the use of additional books.
- The books may be checked out for two weeks at a time, and are renewable once.
- If they cannot return their book, they will need to wait until it has been returned to check out a new one.
- Students may renew a book one time unless the book is on hold for another student. However, the book must be presented in person for renewal.












Feature Comic Strips
