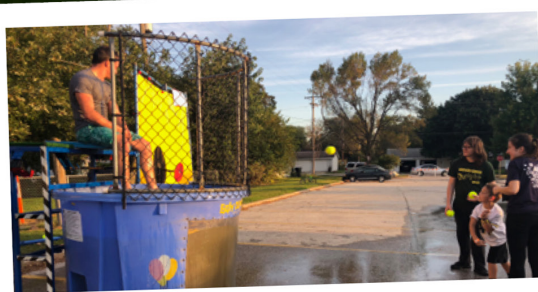
Woodward-Granger Homecoming 2018

An important piece I would like to speak on with this newsletter is our Hawk Time at the middle school level. This takes place during 9th period at the end of the day. Students

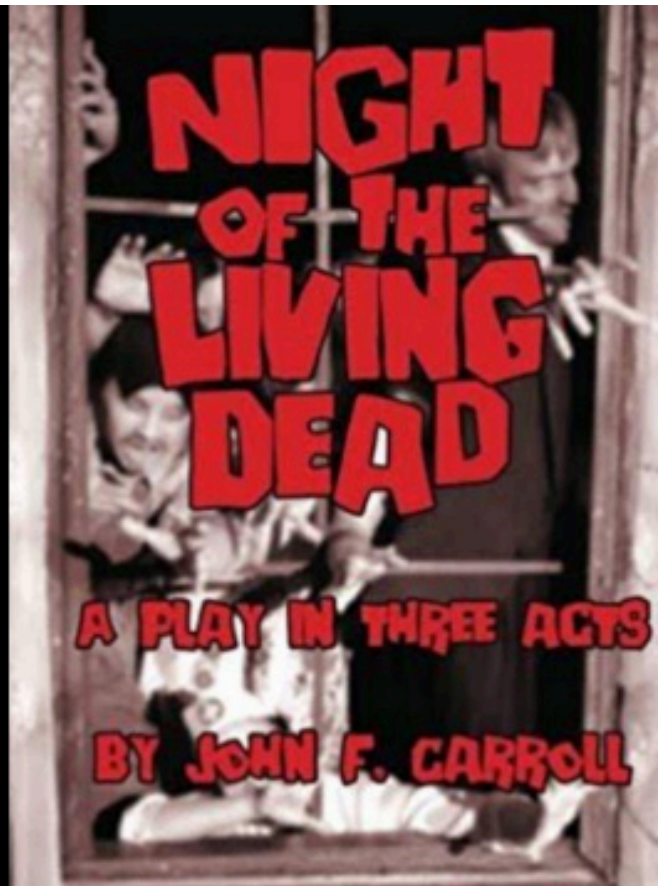

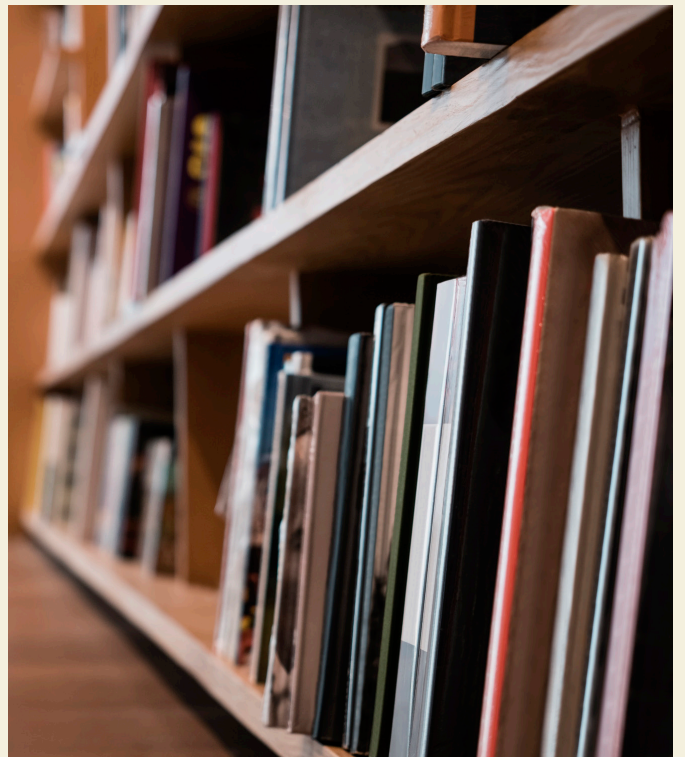

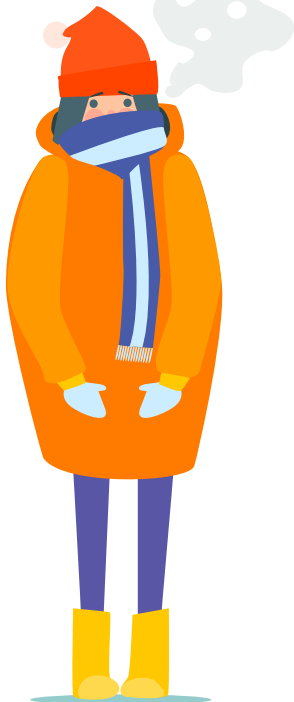
