


Granger community.

parents, sisters, and a VERY loving dog. I currently am a varsity assistant coach for softball and cross country and am excited for the year to come! Go Hawks!




2018 COUNTY FAIR

Dear Grandwood Families,

Now that the school year is in full swing and germs are spreading, I wanted to send out a quick letter to review our health policies.

When does your student need to be excluded from school?

- -When there is a fever over 100.4 degrees temporal
- -Pink eye diagnosed by a physician's office until treatment has been started
- -Presence of a contagious disease
- -Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- -Draining or untreated wounds
- -Rash with fever and/or behavior change
- -Emergency illness or injuries

The student may not return to school until they have been free from fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea for 24 hours. Students must be fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of fever reducing medications (i.e. Tylenol, Acetaminophen, Motrin, Advil, Ibuprofen).

Does my student need to be excluded for head lice?

"We do not exclude for head lice but it must be treated prior to the student returning to school.

Why does the school nurse keep contacting me when my student hits their head? *Policy states that all head injuries shall be reported to a parent and/or guardian, no matter how big or small the bump.

Can the nurse administer medication to my student at school?

"Yes. Please make sure medication is in its original container that has directions. If it is a prescription, please make sure it has a prescription label. Parental permission is also needed to give ANY medication at school.

With cold and flu season quickly approaching, please review proper handwashing with your student at home. Please let me know if you have any other questions or concerns!
